The latest report focused on three fisheries-specific indicators (impact on seabed, impact on targeted stocks, impact on sensitive species), which will be integrated into a voluntary tool. DG MARE established a group to test the new tool. A call for expressions of interest was circulated from 29 November to 13 December 2024.
