Decision	Food Safety	On 18 July 2025, the European Commission adopted a Delegated Regulation setting rules for fishery products frozen in brine on board vessels. Under the new rules, whole fish initially frozen in brine on board vessels at a temperature of not more than -9°C, even if it is subsequently frozen at -18°C, must be exclusively destined for canning or for cooking in establishments carrying out processing operations as defined in Regulation (EC) No 852/2004. Several stakeholders, including MAC members, commissioned a lifecycle assessment on fish boxes in cold chain logistics.
